CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ADOLPH OLSON UMPQUA, OREGON 97486

confirms the right to use the waters of the UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION OF 1.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 28061. The date of priority is MAY 10, 1962. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 3 (NW% SW%), SECTION 21, T 24 S, R 7 W, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2% acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 3 (NW% SW%) 1.1 ACRES SECTION 21
TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm the water right in accordance with OAR 690-15-090(3)(b) for a change in point of diversion not completed under an order of the State Engineer entered AUGUST 15, 1969, approving Transfer Application N-40, and together with Certificate 36479, supersedes Certificate 32074, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
