## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HANSELL BROTHERS, INC. RT. 1, BOX 1710 HERMISTON, OR 97838 SUPERSEDED BY CERT. NO. 8 3 419

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE (1) WELL in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 125.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-2694. The date of priority is MARCH 31, 1964. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.57 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The well is located as follows:

WELL 7: SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 26, T 4 N, R 26 E, W.M.; BEING 1130 FEET NORTH AND 60 FEET EAST FROM THE W 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acrefeet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JANUARY 20, 1982, and supersedes PERMIT G-2694, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.
