CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SQUAW CREEK IRRIGATION DISTRICT
PO BOX 2230
SISTERS, OREGON 97759

confirms the right to use the waters of SQUAW CREEK, a tributary of THE DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATING 390.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permits 987 & 1544. The dates of priority are January 30, 1912 AND January 24, 1913. This right is limited to 4.95 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, being 4.59 CFS FOR JANUARY 30, 1912 AND 0.36 CFS FOR JANUARY 24, 1913, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW¼ SW¼, SECTION 21, T. 15 S., R. 10 E., W.M.; 998 FEET NORTH AND 1211 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate is issued to confirm changes in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DEC 29 1997, in Special Order Volume 51, Page 1408, approving the Squaw Creek Irrigation District petition for water rights mapping under ORS 541.325 to 541.333 and supersedes certificates 1353, 2198, and 2917.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
