CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHESTER & PAMELA FRIEND

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 55.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5186. The date of priority is JUNE 15, 1973. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.69 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 13, T. 14 S., R. 11 E., W.M.; 1120 FEET NORTH & 940 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate is issued to confirm changes in place of use approved by an order of the Director entered DEC 29 1997, 1997, and recorded in Special Order Volume 51, Page 1408 approving a petition by Squaw Creek Irrigation District under ORS 541.325 to 541.333 for mapping water rights within a district and supersedes Certificate 57439, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
