CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MARC AND PAMELA THALACKER
70625 NW LOWER BRIDGE WAY
TERREBONNE, OR 97760

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 85.5 ACRES AND POND MAINTENANCE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8683. The date of priority is OCTOBER 18, 1979. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.33 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, BEING 1.07 CFS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION AND 0.26 CFS FOR POND MAINTENANCE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The well is located as follows:

SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄, SECTION 17, T. 14 S., R. 12 E., W.M.; 20 FEET SOUTH AND 980 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF THE SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄ OF SECTION 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

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This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and type of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered ~~DEC 29 1997~~ 1997, and recorded in Special Order Volume 51, Page 1408, approving a petition by Squaw Creek Irrigation District under ORS 541.325 to 541.333 for mapping water rights within a district.
