CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ARLAN T. KEETON & KEITH CYRUS  
STAR ROUTE  
REDMOND, OR 97756

confirms the right to use the waters of the CYRUS-KEETON WELL in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 292.7 ACRES AND POND MAINTENANCE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6857. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 27, 1976 . The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3.66 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, BEING 3.63 CFS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION AND 0.03 CFS FOR POND MAINTENANCE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NW¼ NW¼, SECTION 13, T. 15 S., R. 10 E., W.M.; 180 FEET SOUTH AND 60 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in place and type of use approved by an order of the Director entered on ~~DEC 29 1997~~ 1997, and recorded in Special Order Volume 51, Page 1408, approving a petition by Squaw Creek Irrigation District under ORS 541.325 to 541.333 for mapping water rights within a district and supersedes Certificate 57135, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
