CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

TUMALO IRRIGATION DISTRICT  
64697 COOK AVENUE  
BEND, OREGON 97701

confirms the right to use the waters of THE DESCHUTES RIVER, a tributary of THE COLUMBIA RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, INDUSTRIAL USE, POND MAINTENANCE, AND STORAGE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for DESCHUTES County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 9, at Page 362. The date of priority is 1905.

The use is limited to the amount beneficially used and shall not EXCEED 9.50 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, INDUSTRIAL USE, AND POND MAINTENANCE DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON FROM APRIL 1 TO NOVEMBER 1, AND STORAGE OF SAID WATER IN CRESCENT LAKE RESERVOIR DURING THE NON-IRRIGATION SEASON, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 32, T. 17 S., R. 12 E., W.M.; 100 FEET SOUTH AND 550 FEET EAST FROM THE N $\frac{1}{4}$  CORNER OF SECTION 32.


The lands on which this right may be used are described as follows:

"The Deschutes County Municipal Improvement District is hereby given the right to use said 9 $\frac{1}{2}$  second feet of water for the irrigation of lands within said district during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1, and to store said water in its reservoir at Crescent Lake during the non-irrigation season so that the water so stored may be released at such later date as the district sees fit to use the same for the irrigation of lands within the district. The storage, diversion and use of said 9 $\frac{1}{2}$  second feet of water by said district shall be subject to all the provisions and limitations contained in Paragraph 33 of said order of determination of June 21, 1926." (Decree dated February 10, 1928, signed by T.E.J. Duffy, Circuit Judge)

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUN 19 1997, in Special Order Volume 51, Page 75, approving the Tumalo Irrigation District petition for water rights mapping under ORS 541.325 to 541.333 and supersedes certificate 31412.
