confirms the right to use the waters of THREE WELLS in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATING 235.8 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 120.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4396. The date of priority is APRIL 15, 1969. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 4.45 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, being 0.80 cfs from well No. 1, 1.48 cfs from well #2, and 2.17 cfs from well #3, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 18 & NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 19, both in T. 14 S., R. 12 E., W.M.; NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 35, T. 14 S., R. 11 E., W.M.; No. 1 - 1050 feet North and 6980 feet West from the SE Corner of Section 17; No. 2 - 2380 feet North and 4420 feet West from the SE Corner of Section 19, T. 14 S., R. 12 E., W.M.; No. 3 - 5520 feet South and 770 feet West from NE Corner Section 26, T. 14 S., R. 11 E., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


The wells shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 49161, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered DEC 29 1997, 1997, and recorded in Special Order Volume 51, Page 1408, approving a petition by Squaw Creek Irrigation District under ORS 541.325 to 541.333 for mapping water rights within a district and together with Certificate 74140 supersedes Certificate 49161.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
