This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is the year 1885.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed a reasonable amount for domestic, stock use and 0.28 cubic foot per second for irrigation, the total quantity being limited to four acre feet per acre during each year. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

10.0 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4
12.0 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4

Township 14 South, Range 17 East, WM

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
