CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

NORBERT SIEG AND DESMOND SIEG  
1045 E STREET  
BAKER, OREGON 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of A Well, a tributary of the Pine Creek, for the supplemental irrigation of 606.1 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7630. The date of priority is June 9, 1977. The use is limited to 7.58 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 21, Township 8 South, Range 39 East, WM; 1840 feet North and 1370 feet West from SE Corner, Section 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
