CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MYRA L. ANDERSON
6270 NEILL ROAD
GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of the APPLGATE RIVER, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 2.86 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 15833. The date of priority is June 21, 1944.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 31, T 36 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 10 FEET SOUTH AND 1980 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 31.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second, and together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion under the subject right.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season FROM APRIL 2 TO OCTOBER 31 OF EACH YEAR.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 2.86 ACRES
SECTION 31
TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

Land on which water is to used is a part of the property more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: All that portion of the Northwest one quarter of the Northeast one quarter of Section 31, Township 36 South, Range 6 West of the Willamette Meridian, lying north of the Redwood Highway.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEBRUARY 14, 1983, and together with Certificate 51524, supersedes Certificate 15315, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
