CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JACK AND BETTY LONGMAN
2200 DICK GEORGE ROAD
CAVE JUNCTION, OR 97523

confirms the right to use the waters of the ALTHOUSE CREEK, tributary of the ILLINOIS RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 6.02 ACRES.

The right was originally confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JOSEPHINE County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 427. The date of priority is 1870.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.12 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 7, T 40 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 280 FEET NORTH AND 320 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 7.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under this subject right, and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

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When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 5, 1985, and together with Certificate 53632, supersedes Certificate 53115.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
