CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WM. MESKE
MURPHY, OREGON 97533

confirms the right to use the waters of CARIS CREEK, a tributary of the APPLGATE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 2.3 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1908.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

G.W. BAILEY DITCH.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE¼ NE¼ 2.3 ACRES
SECTION 36
TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 16293, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 11, 1997, approving Transfer Application 7263.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
