CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM M. AND MEDORA B. NANKERVIS  
13497 E. EVANS CREEK ROAD  
ROGUE RIVER, OR 97537

confirms the right to use the waters of MAYS CREEK, a tributary of EVANS CREEK, for IRRIGATING 3.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 18. The date of priority is 1901.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 32, T 34 S, R 3 W,; 2990 FEET NORTH AND 1080 FEET WEST FROM THE S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4      1.3 ACRES  
SE 1/4 NW 1/4      1.7 ACRES  
SECTION 32  
TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION, approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 29, 1982 and together with Certificate 51335, supersedes Certificate 50148, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion and SHALL NOT EXCEED 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
