CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That **Margaretha, F. C. Nootnagel, and J. W. Berry**

of **Sisters**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Cold Springs, Trout Creek & Nootnagel Reservoir**, to be constructed under Permit No. **R381** a tributary of **Squaw Creek** for the purpose of **Irrigation and Supplemental Supply** under Permit No. **3145** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **January 29, 1916:**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **7.50 cubic feet per second:**

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where the water is put to beneficial use), is as follows: **40 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 40 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 40 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, and 40 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, 40 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 10 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 20 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 20 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 10 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, 20 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 30, Township 14 South, Range 10 East, W.M., 5 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 30 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 40 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 40 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 6, Township 15 South, Range 10 East, W.M.**

Supplemental supply for the following: **20 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 10 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 30 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 20 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, 40 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 40 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, 20 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 30, Township 14 South, Range 10 East, W.M., 35 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 10 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 6, Township 15 South, Range 10 East, of Willamette Meridian, in Crook County, Oregon.**

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
