CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PORT OF HOOD RIVER

HOOD RIVER, OREGON 97031

confirms the right to use the waters of WASTE OR SEEPAGE WATER, a tributary of HOOD RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 10.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 6495. The date of priority is AUGUST 14, 1924. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.13 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

S 1/2 S 1/2 SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 11 T. 2 N., R. 10 E.,  
W. M., BEING 220 FEET NORTH FROM THE W 1/4 SECTION 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

10.0 ACRES N 1/2 S 1/2 SW 1/4 NW 1/4  
SECTION 11  
T. 2 N., R. 10 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said permit.

This certificate confirms an order of the Director entered on JUN 19 1997, 1997 and recorded in Special Order Volume 51, page 860, approving a petition by FARMERS IRRIGATION DISTRICT under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes certificate 5434.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
