CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WALTER AND CHRISTINE NANCE
2867 REED ROAD
HOOD RIVER, OREGON 97031

confirms the right to use the waters of DITCH CREEK AND SPRING CREEK, a tributary of HOOD RIVER, for IRRIGATION 3.6 ACRES, SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 6.4 ACRES, AND DOMESTIC.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for HOOD RIVER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 200. The date of priority is 1897.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

3.0 ACRES NE 1/4 SW 1/4 (SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION)
3.4 ACRES SE 1/4 SW 1/4 (SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION)
3.6 ACRES SE 1/4 SW 1/4 (PRIMARY IRRIGATION)
SE 1/4 SW 1/4 (DOMESTIC)
SECTION 20
T. 2 N., R. 10 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate confirms an order of the Director entered on JUN 19 1997, 1997 and recorded in Special Order Volume 51, page 860, approving a petition by FARMERS IRRIGATION DISTRICT under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes certificate 14976.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
