CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

VIC SNYDER P.O. BOX 835 HOOD RIVER, OREGON 97031

confirms the right to use the waters of DITCH CREEK, a tributary of HOOD RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 9.3 ACRES, DOMESTIC, AND STOCK.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for HOOD RIVER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 200. The date of priority is JANUARY 17, 1889.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SMITH IRRIGATION DITCH.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

8.3 ACRES NE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.0 ACRE SW 1/4 NE 1/4 SECTION 20 T. 2 N., R. 10 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by certificate 15043 State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on __________, and recorded in Special Order Volume 51, page __________, approving a petition by FARMERS IRRIGATION DISTRICT under ORS 541.329. This certificate supersedes certificate 15043.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
