PROPOSED CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ESTATE OF FRANK ASHER
PO BOX 365
MT. VERNON, OREGON 97865

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 9.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 24883. The date of priority is MAY 15, 1957. This right is limited to 0.24 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

DIV # 4 - LOT 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) SECTION 6, T 11 S, R 26 E, W.M., 3360 FEET NORTH AND 1720 FEET WEST; MORRISON DITCH - NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 7, T 11 S, R 26 E, W.M., 3600 FEET SOUTH AND 420 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM THE SOUTH $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER OF SECTION 6.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)	6.5 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	1.5 ACRES
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$	1.4 ACRES
LOT 6 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)	0.3 ACRES

SECTION 6

TOWNSHIP 11 SOUTH, RANGE 26 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 60831, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 22 1997, 1997, approving Transfer Application 7193.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
