## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

VETERANS ADMINISTRATION MEDICAL CENTER GARDEN VALLEY BOULEVARD ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of the SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 38.4 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 25580. The date of priority is JUNE 13, 1958. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.48 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

DIVERSION 1 - LOT 4 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 13, T 27 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 1270 FEET NORTH AND 180 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 13.

DIVERSION 2 - SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 14, T 27 S, R 6 W, W.M.; SECTION 14, 940 FEET NORTH AND 120 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

LOT 14 (SE 1/4 NE 1/4) 1.6 ACRES LOT 1 (NE 1/4 SE 1/4) 5.6 ACRES SECTION 14

TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 31949, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 28, 1984, approving Transfer Application 5477.
