CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN WOOD  
9464 LITTLE RIVER ROAD  
GLIDE, OREGON 97443

confirms the right to use the waters of THE LITTLE RIVER, a tributary of THE NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATING 2.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 19357. The date of priority is MARCH 21, 1950. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 7 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 7, T 27 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 720 FEET SOUTH AND 670 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 7.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 7 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4) 2.1 ACRES  
SECTION 7  
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

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This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 1, 1983, and together with Certificate 51845, supersedes Certificate 22323, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
