confirms the right to use the waters of Three Creek, Snow Creek and water stored under permit R-701 in Big Three Creek Lake Reservoir, tributaries of Squaw Creek for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 109.0 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit 12458. The date of priority is March 8, 1923 for Snow Creek and Three Creek and September 12, 1936 for Big Three Creek Lake Reservoir. The use is limited to 2.18 cubic feet per second or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

Three Creek - NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 36, Township 16 South, Range 9 East, WM; Snow Creek - NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 9, Township 17 South, Range 9 East, WM; Big Three Creek Lake Reservoir - SW 1/4, Section 14, Township 17 South, Range 9 East, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

23.5 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4
19.4 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 36
Township 15 South, Range 10 East, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by orders of the Water Resources Director entered December 13, 1949, and May 9, 1980, and together with Certificate 67117 supersedes Certificates 14785, 14786, 14788, 14790, and 14797, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
