CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

L.C. SPAULDING
208 NW CANTON
JOHN DAY, OR 97845

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 32.4 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for GRANT COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1876.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30; further limited to one acre-foot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and 3/4 acre-foot per acre thereafter; total five acre-feet per acre for season, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



SECTION 25
TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 30 EAST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm the right for which an additional point of diversion was approved but not completed under Transfer Application 4834 and this certificate, together with Certificate 50367, supersedes Certificate 15545, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
