CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MICHAEL S. AND LYNN WRIGHT P.O. BOX 257 WILDERVILLE, OREGON 97543

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED SPRING AND SLATE CREEK, tributaries of the APPLEGATE RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND IRRIGATION OF 2.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 36154. The date of priority is MARCH 27, 1972. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.005 CFS FROM THE SPRING FOR DOMESTIC USE AND 0.025 CFS FROM SLATE CREEK FOR IRRIGATION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 3 (NE% NW%), SECTION 15, SE% SW%, SECTION 10, T 37 S, R 7 W, WM; SPRING - 50 FEET SOUTH AND 1010 FEET WEST; CREEK - 550 FEET NORTH AND 1275 FEET WEST; BOTH FROM THE S% CORNER, SECTION 10.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4% acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SPRING

SE% SW% DOMESTIC

CREEK

SE% SW% 0.5 ACRE SECTION 10 TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 56122, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director JUL 18 1997, approving Transfer Application 7090.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
