CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO
A.E. AND R.D. WEIR
ROUTE 1 BOX 5
WAITSBURG, WA. 99361

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, a tributary of UMATILLA RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 59.4 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5091. The date of priority is JUNE 24, 1970. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount of water actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.74 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well.

The point of diversion is from a well located in the NE1/4 SW1/4, Section 33, T4N, R29E, W.M.; 1120 feet South and 1250 feet West from Center, Section 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be further limited to the appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

32.1 acres NE1/4 SW1/4
27.3 acres NW1/4 SW1/4
Section 33
Township 4 North, Range 29 East, W.M.


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by certificate 53478 State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on 4-7, 1998, and recorded in Special Order Volume 52, page 348, approving a petition by Stanfield Irrigation District under ORS 541.329.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said permit.
