confirms the right to use the waters of WELL NO. 4, a tributary of UMATILLA RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 215.3 acres.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6285. The date of priority is AUGUST 7, 1975. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount of water actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.88 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well.

The point of diversion is from a well located in the NE1/4 NW1/4, Section 19, T4N, R29E, / W.M., 50 feet South and 40 feet West from the N1/4 Corner, Section 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
