CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JAMES E. STEARNS, JR.
802 GREEN VALLEY ROAD
OAKLAND, OR 97462

confirms the right to use the waters of CALAPOOYA CREEK, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 4.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 5847. The date of priority is APRIL 20, 1923. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.054 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected in REED DLC 58, SECTION 5, T25S, R5W, WM; 820 FEET SOUTH AND 3080 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF REED DLC 58.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 3.7 ACRES
as projected within REED DLC 58
SECTION 5

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 0.7 ACRES
as projected within REED DLC 58
SECTION 8
TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 66903, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 14 1997, approving Transfer Application 7628.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
