CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

THOS. J. JOHNSON
EAGLE POINT, OREGON 97524

confirms the right to use the waters of the ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION OF 5.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 8572. The date of priority is JULY 5, 1928. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.073 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 16; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 21, T 34 S, R 1 W, W.M..

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 3.4 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 1.0 ACRES
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 1.5 ACRES
SECTION 21

TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 51455, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 26, 1997 in Volume 51, page 577, approving Transfer Application 7069 and NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUL 23 1997, approving Transfer Application 6574.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
