CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of Hunt Spring, tributary to Little McKay Creek for livestock.

This right was perfected under permit 48669. The date of priority is September 11, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.0004 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 24, Township 12 South, Range 17 East, WM, 1386 feet South and 2367 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 24.


The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 24
Township 12 South, Range 17 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
