The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3984 gallons per day, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 26, Township 28 South, Range 6 East, WM, 800 feet South and 2380 feet East from the NW Corner of Section 26.

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 5, Township 29 South, Range 7 East, WM, 210 feet South and 2600 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 5.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
