CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of Bear Creek, tributary to Klamath Marsh for livestock.

This right was perfected under permit 48984. The date of priority is February 2, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3984 gallons per day, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 6, Township 30 South, Range 7 East, WM, 530 feet South and 470 feet East from the NW Corner of Section 6.

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 11, Township 30 South, Range 6 East, WM, 220 feet North and 1270 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 11.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


