CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of Pothole Creek, tributary to Klamath Marsh for livestock.

This right was perfected under permit 48985. The date of priority is February 2, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3984 gallons per day, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 26, Township 30 South, Range 6 East, WM, 1300 feet North and 1110 feet West from the SE Corner of Section 26.

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 25, Township 30 South, Range 6 East, WM, 240 feet North and 1580 feet West from the SE Corner of Section 25.

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 25, Township 30 South, Range 6 East, WM, 500 feet North and 530 feet West from the SE Corner of Section 25.


The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
