CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of Scott Creek, tributary to Klamath Marsh for livestock.

This right was perfected under permit 48986. The date of priority is February 2, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3984 gallons per day, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 18, Township 31 South, Range 7 East, WM, 2880 feet South and 3270 feet East from the NW Corner of Section 18.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
