CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

USFS NO. G14 AND G13

confirms the right to use the waters of Two Unnamed Springs, tributaries to the Williamson River for livestock.

This right was perfected under permit 49217. The date of priority is September 22, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second (cfs), being 0.005 cfs from each spring, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 27, Township 32 South, Range 10 East, WM; 1000 feet North and 1200 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 27.

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 26, Township 32 South, Range 10 East, WM; 1600 feet North and 200 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 26.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 27

NW 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 26
Township 32 South, Range 10 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
