CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of Dice Crane Spring and An Unnamed Spring, tributaries to Hog Creek for livestock.

This right was perfected under permit 49218. The date of priority is September 22, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second (cfs), being 0.005 cfs from each spring, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 24, Township 32 South, Range 8 East, WM; 2200 feet North and 1800 feet West from the SE Corner of Section 24.

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 25, Township 32 South, Range 8 East, WM; 400 feet North and 250 feet West from the SW Corner of Section 25.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



SE 1/4 SE 1/4  
Section 25

Township 32 South, Range 8 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
