confirms the right to use the waters of an unnamed stream, tributary to Lincoln Creek and reservoir constructed under Application R-66705, Permit R-9254, for livestock and wildlife use.

This right was perfected under permit 48169. The date of priority is September 23, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.001 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 13, Township 40 South, Range 3 East, WM, 2200 feet South and 1800 feet East from the NW Corner of Section 13.


The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4  
Section 13  
Township 40 South, Range 3 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
