## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BEVERLY J. NELSON 1055 WEST CATCHING SLOUGH ROAD COOS BAY, OREGON 97420

confirms the right to use the waters of THREE UNNAMED STREAMS AN UNNAMED RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION R-71723, PERMIT R-11416, tributaries of CATCHING SLOUGH, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY, IRRIGATION OF 0.46 ACRE, AND AESTHETICS.

This right was perfected under Permit 51362. The date of priority is JUNE 27, 1991. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.035 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.01 CFS FROM UNNAMED STREAM #1 FOR DOMESTIC USE; 0.01 CFS FROM UNNAMED STREAMS #1, #2, #3, AND RESERVOIR FOR IRRIGATION; AND 0.015 CFS FROM UNNAMED STREAMS #1, #2, AND #3 FOR RESERVOIR MAINTENANCE (AESTHETICS), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 6, T 26 S, R 12 W, W.M.; UNNAMED STREAM #1 - 515.1 FEET NORTH AND 1072.3 FEET WEST; UNNAMED STREAM #2 - 583.5 FEET NORTH AND 884.4 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 6.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 5 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4) 0.46 ACRE AND DOMESTIC SECTION 6
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST W.M.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
