CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SANTOS & ROSE AND SONS, INC.

confirms the right to use the waters of the NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 75.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 40557. The date of priority is APRIL 22, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.888 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW¹/₄ NE¹/₄, NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄, both as projected within HUNTLEY DLC 38, T26S, R4W, WM; 2580 FEET SOUTH AND 2850 FEET EAST, 2700 FEET SOUTH AND 1630 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2¹/₂ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ 13.9 ACRES

SW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ 0.1 ACRE

TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, WM

This certificate is issued to correct a clerical error in certificate 74499 and supersedes certificate 74499.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
