confirms the right to store the waters of McCain Creek, a tributary of Jordan Craters, in Schnable Creek Reservoir, for livestock.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-3798. The date of priority is August 8, 1961. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is not more than 1.16 acre-feet.

The reservoir is located within:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 35
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 44 EAST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to correctly describe the source and supersedes certificate 52108.
