CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT (HB - 2153)

confirms the right to store the waters of UNNAMED INTERMITTENT STREAMS, TRIBUTARIES OF OWYHEE RIVER, BURNT FLAT, AND CROWLEY CREEK IN BENS RES 48-0406, HAMMACK RES 48-5957, AND POOKEY RES 48-5947 for LIVESTOCK AND WILDLIFE.

The right to store and use these waters was perfected under Reservoir Application R-77881. The date of priority is January 1, 1993. The amount of water entitled to be stored and used each year under this right is not more than 1.93 ACRE-FEET, BEING 0.75 AF IN RES 48-0406, 0.94 AF IN RES 48-5957 AND 0.24 AF IN RES 48-5947.

Located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 42 EAST WM.
NE 1/4 NE 1/4 SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST WM.
SW 1/4 SW 1/4 SECTION 17, TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST WM.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, with a minimum diameter of 8", or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary for public safety or to satisfy prior downstream rights as determined by the Water Resources Director.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use listed above.

This certificate is issued to correctly describe the source of water and supersedes certificate 71115.
