CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHARLES V. SHUCK BOX 204 MERRILL, OREGON 97633

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL in the LOST RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 58.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9244. The date of priority is MARCH 5, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.73 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW% NW%, SECTION 33, T 40 S, R 11 E, WM; 1400 FEET SOUTH AND 840 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE¼ NE¼ 37.9 ACRES SECTION 32

SW¼ NW¼ 21.0 ACRES SECTION 33 TOWNSHIP 40 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

This use may be regulated if analysis of data available discloses that the appropriation will measurably reduce the surface water flows necessary to maintain the free-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife in effect as of the priority date of this right or as those quantities may be subsequently reduced.

This certificate is issued to confirm the water right in accordance with OAR 690-15-090(3)(b) for a change in point of appropriation not completed under an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 14, 1997, approving Transfer Application 7731, and supersedes Certificate 65082, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
