CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHARLES H. GOE 3148 WEST GILBERT AVE. ROSEBURG, OR 97470-2328

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 0.4 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 17592. The date of priority is MARCH 6, 1947. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 6 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 14, T 27 S, R 6 W, W.M.; BEING 2750 FEET NORTH AND 290 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 6 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4) 0.4 ACRE SECTION 14 TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST W.M.

LAND ON WHICH WATER IS TO BE USED IS MORE EXPLICITLY DESCRIBED BY THE APPROPRIATOR AS FOLLOWS;

LOT 9 GILBERT ACRES

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 18, 1985, and together with Certificates 57549 AND 75103, supersedes Certificate 19581, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
