 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

L & L FARMS
 P.O. BOX 611
 ECHO, OREGON 97826

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 2, in the SPIKES GULCH RIVER BASIN, for PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 0.6 ACRE AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 259.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6936. The date of priority is JULY 19, 1976. This right is limited to not more than 3.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

WELL 2 - NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 26, T 3 N, R 28 E, W.M.;
 930 FEET SOUTH FROM N $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein for supplemental irrigation shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


The water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used from each well. The type and plans for the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to using the water at the new place of use. Installation and maintenance shall be under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a diminution to supplemental irrigation approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 3, 1997, and together with Certificates 75123 and 75125, supersedes Certificate 72395, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
