## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This is to Certify, That the makion Jack irrigation company

, has made proof . State of Pendleton Oregon to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of McKay Creek

a tributary of Umatilla River for the purpose of Irrigation under Permit No. 1540 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from Jarmary 3, 1912;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.30 cubic feet per second:

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per

acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where the water is put to beneficial use), is as follows: 1 acre in the NELSW1; 22 acres in the NWLSW1; 40 acres in the SWANNA; and 24 acres in the SEASWA; Section 27; 4 acres in the MEASWA and 3 acres in the SEASWA; Section 28; 15 acres in the MWANNA; 13 acres in the SWANNA; 40 acres in the MEANWA; 2 acres in the NWANNA; and 20 acres in the SE 184, Section 34, Township 2 North, Range 32 East of the Willamette Meridian, in Unatilla County, Oregon, being a total of 184 acres.

(This certificate is to correct and supersede that certain Water Right Certificate issued on November 15th, 1922, and recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificate, Volume 5, page 3702.)

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
