CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

U.S. UMPQUA NATIONAL FOREST
P.O. BOX 1008
ROSEBURG, OR 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of DIAMOND LAKE, a tributary of LAKE CREEK, for POTABLE WATER (DOMESTIC) FOR THIELSEN VIEW CAMPGROUND.

This right was perfected under Permit 48555. The date of priority is OCTOBER 5, 1982. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.015 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 1, T 28 S, R 5 E, W.M. (UNSURVEYED)

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 36
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 5 EAST, W.M.

NE 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 1
TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 5 EAST, W.M.

(ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN AN UNSURVEYED AREA)

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
