CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DONALD R. AND/OR JOANNE M. HEWITT
13555 E. EVANS CREEK RD.
ROGUE RIVER, OREGON 97537

confirms the right to use the waters of MAYS CREEK, a tributary of EVANS CREEK, for the IRRIGATION OF 6.5 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 17593. The date of priority is MARCH 6, 1947. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

DIV. PT. #1 - SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 32, T 34 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 1020 FEET NORTH AND 250 FEET WEST FROM THE S 1/4 CORNER SECTION 32; DIV. PT. #2 - NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 5, T 35 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 340 FEET SOUTH AND 300 FEET WEST FROM THE N 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 4.5 ACRES
SECTION 32
TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 2.0 ACRES
SECTION 5
TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2 to October 31 of each year.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 15, 1980, and together with Certificate 50143, supersedes Certificate 46270, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
