CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SID AND NANCY JOHNSON
3150 10TH STREET
BAKER CITY, OREGON 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of ALDER CREEK, a tributary of the BURNT RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 26.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 8, at Page 134. The date of priority is DECEMBER 12, 1903.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed THREE ACRE FEET PER ACRE DURING ANY IRRIGATION SEASON (with the further limitations contained in Paragraph 64 of said decree), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

RESERVOIR DITCH.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW¼ NW¼ 4.2 ACRES
SECTION 26

NE¼ NE¼ 16.8 ACRES
SE¼ SE¼ 5.0 ACRES
SECTION 27

TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 41 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 5860, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOV 14 1997, approving Transfer Application 7469.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
