confirms the right to store the waters of CONNER'S CREEK, a tributary of DAVIS CREEK, in RESERVOIR 2, appropriated under Permit 50446, for IRRIGATION, TEMPERATURE CONTROL AND FLOOD HARVESTING OF CRANBERRIES.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-11011. The date of priority is MARCH 3, 1988. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is not more than 4.54 acre-feet.

The reservoir is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 SECTION 12 TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 15 WEST, W.M.

The use of water is subject to the maintenance of a gate valve or other suitable mechanism in the lowest flashboard approved by the Watermaster for regulating the water.

All flashboards to be removed from the spillway during the period from October 1 through April 1 of each year.

The land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
