CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MELVIN RAYMOND
ROUTE 1, BOX 1515
BANDON, OREGON 97411

confirms the right to use the waters of RESERVOIR 1 CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-5014, RESERVOIR 2 CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-11011 AND CONNERS'S CREEK, tributaries of DAVIS CREEK, for IRRIGATION AND TEMPERATURE CONTROL ON 14.19 ACRES AND FLOOD HARVESTING ON 5.36 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 50446. The date of priority is MARCH 3, 1988. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.12 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.35 CFS FOR IRRIGATION, 2.12 CFS FOR TEMPERATURE CONTROL OR 1.07 CFS FOR FLOOD HARVESTING, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 15 WEST, W.M.;
RESERVOIR 1 - 860 FEET NORTH AND 320 FEET WEST, RESERVOIR 2 AND CONNERS CREEK-
540 FEET NORTH AND 800 FEET WEST, ALL FROM THE S 1/4 CORNER SECTION 12.

For the irrigation of **cranberries**, the amount of water diverted is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre feet per acre per year during the irrigaiton season each year. For the irrigation of **any other crop** the amount of water diverted is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre feet per acre per year during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
