CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RONALD R. AND DEBRA K. SIEBERT
5734 PLEASANT CREEK ROAD
ROGUE RIVER, OREGON 97537

confirms the right to use the waters of PLEASANT CREEK, a tributary of EVANS CREEK, for IRRIGATING 3.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1862.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 22, T 34 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 2870 FEET NORTH AND 2000 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 22.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 3.0 ACRES
SECTION 22
TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 20, 1980, and together with Certificate 49451, supersedes Certificate 16127, State Record of Water Right Certificates.


The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
